Log Cabin Invitational Golf Tournament Fundraiser

The residents of Innsbrook formed the Innsbrook Historical Society (IHS) with the mission “... *To restore and preserve historic structures and adjacent properties within the Village of Innsbrook in order to educate and deepen the understanding of the legacy of the land and its inhabitants for future generations ...*”

The funds raised from our annual golf tournament have helped us meet this mission. Our IHS Historic Village now includes a restored 1840's Dog Trot Log Cabin, a log tobacco drying barn which has been turned into a tool museum, a pavilion erected on the foundation of the original log barn, a repurposed tool shed, the relocated and restored Upper Charrette historic one room schoolhouse and a sanitary restroom disguised as an old farm shed.

This past year (2023) we were lucky enough to have an old 1890's barn donated by Dave and Diane Vaughn. Our IHS volunteers deconstructed the barn, recovered and stored all the timbers. Late last year we developed the site and poured the floor. We have started the rebuild of the barn which will serve as the centerpiece for our new venue as well as a great piece of history. The materials from the old barn will be used to initiate this project but funding is needed for roofing, doors/windows and lumber for extensions to the original barn.



Your support this year will enable our volunteers to add a barn to our Historic Village. As old barns are being replaced with metal sheds IHS wanted to ensure that an old wood barn was a part of our Historic Village so that our grandchildren could experience the fun of playing in a barn, climbing in a hay loft and seeing how a barn was a key part of our ancestor's way of life.

The Innsbrook Historical Society's 13th Annual Log Cabin Invitational Golf Tournament fundraiser will be held on May 20, 2024. It will include lunch and a four-person shotgun scramble, with on-course games and cash prizes. An after golf mingle will be held after the tournament with beverage and appetizers to replay those great drives, 40-foot puts and award prizes.
